Student Led Conferences Coming to Southwood



Parent teacher conferences are taking on a new look at Southwood this November. Traditionally we have had parents meet with the classroom teacher for ten minutes to discuss the strengths and challenges of the current school year. We feel there is a key component missing from this equation...the student. This year we are pleased to include the student as we move to student-led conferences that engage them in the process. These conferences can provide powerful opportunities for students to advocate for their own learning.

How Do Student-Led Conferences (SLCs) Work?

Though the format may vary, these conferences differ from traditional conferences in that they place students at the helm of teacher-supported discussions with parents about student progress and learning. SLCs also often present opportunities for students to prepare, reflect on, and discuss evidence of their learning and growth by way of student portfolios.

Schools that implement student-led conferences report that they:

- Encourage students to take responsibility and ownership for their learning by involving them in the goal-setting and assessment process.
- Engage families in richer, more transparent conversations about student learning.

Once again, parents will be able to sign up for a half hour appointment where your child will lead you through their learning thus far. We look forward to this exciting time for you and your child. If you have any questions feel free to contact your child's teacher.


