- 1) Welcome PL & RT. Meeting began at 6:32pm.
- 2) Principal's Report RK:
 - a. New secretary: Shae-Lynn has replaced Michelle Davis. New Youth support workers, EAs, 2 maternity leaves coming up.
 - b. RE: "Momo Challenge". Refer to statement delivered throughout HSD by Randy Dueck. Please let the school know if you have any concerns.
 - c. RE: Dr.Gordon Neufeld-Feedback from attendance is positive
 - d. PAC Liaison Mtg is 7pm on Apr.23
 - e. Gr.4 Transition Planning: Transition visits-1 planned each month: April, May and large one in June.
 - f. Upcoming events:
 - i. Community Breakfast (Apr.4, 8:15-9:15am). Partnered with Lions Club.
 \$3.00 for a pancake BF, coffee & juice, students are free. Being held in the gym.
 - g. **Add on:** projects stemming from PAC fundraising, proposed ideas are on the back of report. Consider as fundraising for next year.

<u>Discussion</u>: Chromebooks are requested to replace the current laptops which are old. Chromebooks are suggested because that's what's being used in middle/high school.

Gr.4 farewell & kindergarten welcome will happen regardless of funding assistance.

- 3) **Financial Update** AK: Month end balance is at \$2400 with 2 outstanding checks. Anticipate ~\$900 once all checks are cashed. To date we've earned ~\$5900.
- 4) **Hot Lunch/MAL Overview** RT: Ruth continues to inquire with McDs, her inquiries are not being answered. Do we continue with 2d/wk or drop to 1x/wk? Voting to eliminate Monday HL come April as we are short on volunteers.

Discussion around MAL for next year: Whether to eliminate kindergarten HL next year d/t time difference in Nutrition Break. The opposite times in Nutrition breaks pose a challenge to delivering hot food to students. Topic will continue to be discuss.
