All entries must include and consist of the following steps:

1.	Step One - Ask an adult if you can conduct an experiment.
2.	Step Two - Ask a Question? - What are you trying to create or prove with your scientific
	experiment? Include a hypothesis if you can. A hypothesis is an educated guess about
	how things work. It is an attempt to answer your question with an explanation that can
	be tested. A good hypothesis allows you to then make a prediction:
	"If[I do this], then[this] will happen."
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- 3. Step 3 List the Steps What are your steps to your scientific process? Be sure to list the materials you required to conduct your experiment.
- 4. Step 4 Record the results of your experiment Once your experiment is complete, you collect your measurements and analyze them to see if they support your hypothesis or not.
